Occasional Table LTR

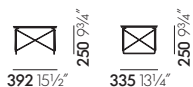
The LTR (Low Table Rod Base, 1950) is a small, versatile occasional table designed by Charles and Ray Eames, who used it in their own home in a variety of different ways. A number of these tables are still found in the Eames House today. Standing individually or in groups, some

are decorated with objects from the Eames collection, while others simply serve as a practical side table next to an armchair or sofa.

Materials

- **Table top:** plywood, hard laminate surface. LTR Gold Leaf with gold leaf surface, transparent coating.
- **Base:** chrome-plated steel wire.

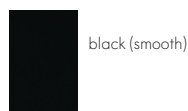

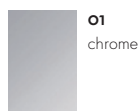
