

The PK24™ chaise longue chair, with its easy curves and organic shape, stands out as perhaps the most recognizable chair in Poul Kjærholm's work. Inspiration for this chair comes from the Rococo period and the French chaise longue – long chair – that featured the same curve and size. The chair is a prime and almost extreme example of Kjærholm's principle of designing with independent elements. Consequently, the chair has no physical connection between the main parts, which are instead kept together by gravity and the friction between the elements. Kjærholm also labelled the PK24 the "Hammock Chair" to stress that the chair functioned by suspending the body between two points. The base of the PK24 is in satin brushed stainless steel, the seat is available in wicker and leather, both versions includes a leather headrest.





POUL KIÆRHOLM 1929-1980

Poul Kjærholm was a trained carpenter and continued his studies at the Danish School of Arts and Crafts. He had a particular interest in different construction materials; especially steel which he considered a natural material with the same artistic fineness as other natural materials. Poul Kjærholm was first employed at Fritz Hansen for about a year, where he designed a number of noteworthy chair prototypes. In 1955 Poul Kjærholm initiated his collaboration with manufacturer Ejvind Kold Christensen, which lasted until Poul Kjærholm's death in 1980. In 1982, Fritz Hansen took over "The Kjærholm Collection", developed from 1951 to 1967, designs, which are logical to the minute detail with an aura of exclusivity.

DESIGN

DESCRIPTION

Chaise longue designed by Poul Kjærholm, manufactured by Fritz Hansen.

Seat and back are curved on a steel frame covered with handwoven wicker or leather – they glide on the frame thus adjusting to the desired position. Head cushion - covered in leather and with a counterweight of stainless steel - is adjustable, optimizing the comfort and rest. The frame is stainless steel


Leather model: The leather includes Classic, Natural, White, Optical white, and Elegance.

Wicker model: The head rest in leather includes Classic, Natural, White, Optical white, and Elegance.
